



We are always looking for new and exciting field trip opportunities. Some future trips we are working on include walks of the river valley, and a trip to Head Smashed in Buffalo Jump.

Every semester we make the following trips around Edmonton:

Elder Visit: Students visit Elder Francis Whiskey Jack at Amiskwaciy Academy in his cultural lodge. Elder Francis Whiskey Jack provides students with teachings on Indigenous traditions and beliefs.

Feasts: Amiskwaciy Academy holds four annual Feasts per year, and we attend all of them. Students get to take part in a huge meal and learn about the Feast ceremony as well as getting entertained by a variety of cultural dancing and singing.

Jasper Place Pow Wow: In the spring students will get to attend the annual Pow Wow at Jasper Place high school. Students will learn about the cultural practices included in the Pow Wow, as well as taking part in some round dancing and other Pow Wow dances.

Royal Albert Museum Visit: One of the highlights of the course is our annual trip to the museum and a visit to the Aboriginal gallery. Students explore pieces of Aboriginal history, from the distant past and from modern history. Connections are made between what is learned throughout the year and what is observed in the museum.
