



Aboriginal Studies 30 at Centre High has 4 units. Students will first be engaged in material from Aboriginal Studies 10 and 20 to provide base level knowledge needed to move forward with the 30 level curriculum.

Unit 1: Traditional First Nations Culture and European Contact

Students will demonstrate an understanding of the some basic cultural beliefs and practices of First Nations groups in North America and the impact of European Colonization on these populations.

Unit 2: Aboriginal Rights, Law, and Land Claims

Students will demonstrate an understanding of Aboriginal land rights, entitlements and current land claim negotiations with the Government of Canada.

Unit 3: Residential Schools

Students will demonstrate an understanding of the impact of colonialism experienced by Aboriginal peoples in Alberta and Canada.

Unit 4: Australia Comparative Study

Students will demonstrate an understanding that indigenous peoples around the world face common issues in their history, geography, politics, economics, education and culture
