

# Arc card on SchoolZone

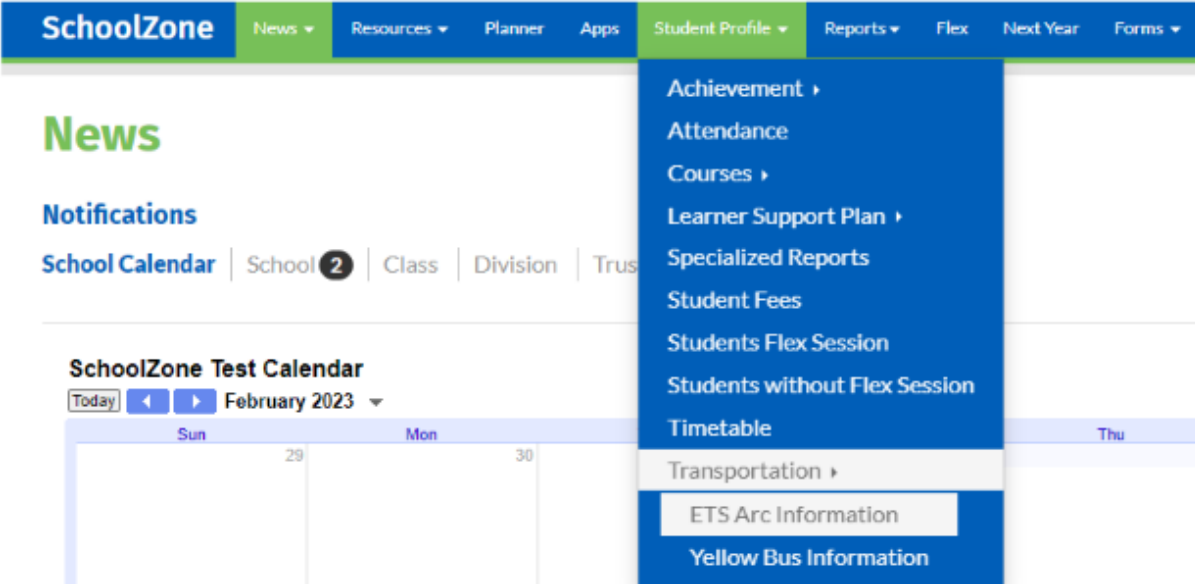
Students and families can now register and add monthly bus passes to their electronic [Arc cards](#) through SchoolZone.

## Registering your Arc card

Before you can add a monthly bus pass to an Arc card, you need to register the card on SchoolZone. To register an Arc card you first need a physical card. You can get a physical Arc card from the school at no cost and purchase monthly bus passes for it through SchoolZone.

Follow these steps to register an Arc card:

1. Sign in to [SchoolZone](#).
2. Click on the 'Student Profile' option from the main menu.
3. From the 'Student Profile' menu option, select the 'Transportation' option, then the 'ETS Arc Information' option (shown in the image below). A page called 'Arc Card Registration' will appear.

4. On the 'Arc Card Registration' page, enter the card number (shown as 'account number' in the image below) from the back of the Arc card and the security code from the front of the card into the blank boxes.

- Click 'Register'. The Arc card is now registered and you can purchase monthly bus passes through the 'Fees' option in the main menu.

### Adding a monthly bus pass to your Arc card

1. Buying a bus pass is the same process as before. Click the **'Fees'** option in the main menu and add the **'[Month] Bus Pass ETS Arc Card'** option from the drop down.
2. The rate for a monthly bus pass remains the same for students.
3. After you have paid, SchoolZone will confirm that you have completed the payment. Once a monthly bus pass is added onto the card, the system will validate an Arc card **only three times a day** (4 a.m., 12 p.m. and 8 p.m.). **These times may affect when your Arc card is ready to use.** After the card is validated in the system, the card can then be used to access Edmonton Transit Services (e.g., if you pay for a bus pass at 10 a.m., it will be ready to use on the Arc card at 12 p.m.).

### Paying your fees

1. **How to pay monthly bus pass fees through SchoolZone**
  - a. Once you have registered an Arc card, you can add a monthly bus pass to the card.
  - b. Select **'[Month] Bus Pass - ETS Arc Card'** in the list of fees and click **'Done'**. The fee will now be added to your **'Fee List'** so that you can make a payment for the monthly pass.

### Misplaced or stolen Arc cards

1. A student's first Arc card is available from the school, at no cost. If a student loses this card and needs a replacement, there are purchase options available at [myarc.ca/features/where-to-buy](http://myarc.ca/features/where-to-buy) for a small fee. To ensure your balance gets transferred to your new replacement Arc card, you can also [register it with the City of Edmonton](#).
2. After you receive a replacement card, you need to register the new card in SchoolZone by following the steps above under 'Registering your Arc card'. Once the new card is registered, the misplaced or stolen card will show as 'Removed' and will no longer be usable. SchoolZone will then begin transferring the purchased monthly bus passes from the old card to the new card. You will see this as 'Pending' on SchoolZone.
3. Once the new card shows as 'Validated' (see the image below), you can then add additional monthly bus passes to your new Arc card. Validation will happen three times a day—4 a.m., 12 p.m. and 8 p.m.
